



## PAUL VEXLER | TWISTED

Paul Vexler's delicate wood sculptures have evolved from his understanding of geometry in the natural world. The fluidity in which Paul creates sculpture in wood is astounding. He makes his own plywood veneers with just the right amount of strength and flexibility. Giant bands of wooden ribbon seamlessly float upon suspended cables or project vertically from a solid base.

Paul describes the philosophy of his art, "I want people to approach my work and feel compelled to walk around it and view it from different angles. I want them to walk around it two or three times because the work is helping them to learn to see things that they missed the first time. And most of all, I want them to experience the pleasure of seeing something beautiful."
