Darlene Cole received her B.A. in Fine Art from Queen's University, Kingston and her Masters of Fine Arts from the University of Waterloo. Darlene Cole is an established Canadian artist with an impressive exhibition history (Robert McLaughlin Gallery, Oshawa; Agnes Etherington Art Centre, Kingston; and the Kitchener-Waterloo Art Gallery, Kitchener) and is represented in collections across Canada, the U.S.A. and the United Kingdom. From small oil on panel works to large-scale canvases, Cole captures loosely rendered moments in time. Her gestural brushstrokes and curiously cropped imagery create both energy and tension.
