JEFFREY MILSTEIN

A professional photographer, graphic designer, and architect, Jeffrey Milstein infuses his photography with his lifelong creative passion and fascination for flight. His trained eye and steady hand produce images of pristine clarity that focus on design, colour and symmetry. Carefully positioned and using an ultra high-resolution digital camera, he skillfully photographs aircrafts, airports, cities, ports and watercrafts in a style that emulates the rich, graphic quality of architectural drawings. Milstein's supersized prints seem to pull you into the air, as though you're going along for the ride.

Milstein's photographs have been published in Men's Vogue, TIME Magazine, European Photography, American Photo, Eyemazing, Die Zeit, Wired, PDN, Esquire and Conde Nast Portfolio. His acclaimed series "Aircraft: The Jet as Art" was exhibited in a year-long solo show at the National Air and Space Museum at the Smithsonian in Washington, DC from November 2011 - November 2012. Born in Los Angeles, where he frequently returns to shoot at the International Airport, Milstein makes his home in Woodstock, NY.
